## How to Get There

**BY AIR** Cathay Pacific and Air New Zealand operate direct flights daily from Auckland to Hong Kong.

Macau is a 55 minute ferry transfer from Kowloon and Hong Kong Island or 45 minutes from Hong Kong International Airport. See page 32 for details.

## Visas & Passports

New Zealand passport holders must have a valid passport with at least six months' validity beyond their stay in Hong Kong and Macau. New Zealand passport holders do not require a visa for visits of up to 90 days in Hong Kong and 60 days in Macau. Travel advice is available from the New Zealand Government Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade at [www.safetravel.govt.nz](http://www.safetravel.govt.nz).

Major credit cards are widely accepted and ATMs are widespread throughout Hong Kong and Macau.

## Tipping

Most restaurants will levy a 10% service charge. However tipping is discretionary.

## Language

**Hong Kong:** Cantonese and English are the official languages, communicating with locals is easy as English is widely spoken.

**Macau:** Chinese and Portuguese are the official languages, with Cantonese and English being widely spoken.

## Weather Guide

**Hong Kong** has a subtropical climate with distinct seasons. The warmest months are from late May to September and the cool winter months from December to February.

### Temperature average in Hong Kong

Summer (Dec – Feb)	14°C to 21°C
Autumn (Mar – May)	17°C to 29°C
Winter (Jun – Aug)	26°C to 32°C
Spring (Sep – Nov)	19°C to 30°C

**Macau** has a tropical climate and the weather is generally hot and humid, the rainy season is from July to September.

Autumn (Mar – May)	16°C to 28°C

### 1. A Symphony of Lights

A spectacular nightly multimedia show involving more than 40 buildings on both sides of the harbour. Witness coloured lights, laser beams and searchlights perform in an unforgettable all round spectacle synchronised to music and narration that celebrates the energy, spirit and diversity of Hong Kong. Head to Tsim Sha Tsui Promenade or Golden Bauhinia Square in Wan Chai to watch the show or take a harbour cruise for the best vantage point. (see page 14 for details)

### 2. Hong Kong Disneyland

Enter a magical kingdom inspired by fairy tale dreams and explore seven fun filled lands – Adventureland, Grizzly Gulch, Mystic Point, Toy Story Land, Fantasyland, Tomorrowland and Main Street, U.S.A. Meet your favourite characters and experience Disney Parks' first Marvel-themed ride, the all-new 'Iron Man Experience'. (see page 17 for details)

### 3. The Peak

### 5. Markets

Hong Kong's markets are famed as places to pick up fashionable and cheap clothing, accessories, jewellery, electronics, toys and a whole lot more. The most famous market is the Ladies' Market on Tung Choi Street. Also popular is the Temple Street Night Market, in addition to street stalls you'll find fortune tellers, street performers and a myriad of dining options. (see pages 14 and 15 for details)

### 6. The Ruins of St Paul's, Macau

The most treasured icon in Macau, the towering façade and the grand stone stairway are all that remain of this early 17th century church. The site forms part of the 'Historic Centre of Macau' which is UNESCO World Heritage Listed.

### 7. Horse Racing

Experience a day or night out at the races as top-flight horses, jockeys and trainers vie for huge purses in thrilling races at Happy Valley Racecourse on Hong Kong Island and Sha Tin Racecourse in the New Territories. Hong Kong's racing season runs from September to July.

### 8. Senado Square & A-Ma Temple, Macau

Famed for its wave patterned mosaic of coloured stones and a popular place for cultural activities and celebrations, Senado Square is part of the UNESCO World Heritage Listed 'Historic Centre of Macau'. Built in 1488 and the oldest temple in Macau, A-Ma Temple is one of three famous Buddha halls. (see page 15 for details)

### 9. Tian Tan Buddha & Po Lin Monastery

While on Lantau Island climb the stairs to the Tian Tan Buddha. Also known as the 'Big Buddha', it stands 34 metres high and is made of bronze. Opposite the statue is Po Lin Monastery, a Buddhist sanctum set in lush mountains. (see page 15 for details)

### 10. Lang Kwai Fong Nightlife

Hong Kong boasts entertainment galore and most of it kicks off after sunset. Whether you're after a classy cocktail in a trendy bar or live entertainment that beats through the night, Hong Kong is the city to oblige. Lan Kwai Fong in Central, is packed full of bars and nightclubs, with revellers spilling out onto the streets at all hours.





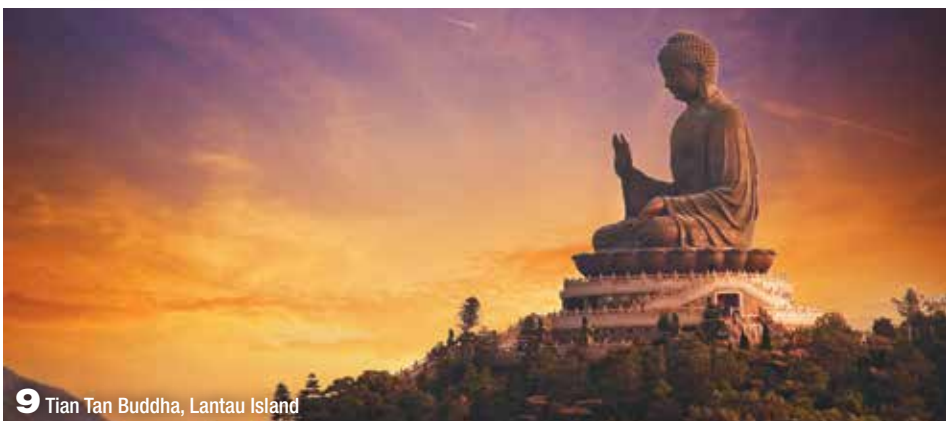

Nan Lian Garden, Kowloon

Exotic, vibrant, colourful and buzzing with people, Hong Kong is an unforgettable city that will stimulate the senses like no other. From its towering modern skyscrapers and sophisticated restaurants to its street-style markets and roadside food stalls, it's a fascinating place full of wonderful things to see and do. The spectacular harbour vistas, lofty mountain peaks and the famous neon-lit alleys will wow you. The extravagant designer shopping malls and the colourful, bustling night markets will satisfy any shopping enthusiast. For another feast of the senses, take the hour-long ferry trip to Macau to experience its unique mix of Portuguese and Chinese cultures and of course, its famous Las Vegas-style casinos.

## Hong Kong

Hong Kong is a story in three parts: Hong Kong Island, Kowloon Peninsula and the New Territories. Together, they're a combination of modern skyscrapers and ancient temples, vibrant markets, beaches, mountains and deserted islands. Then there is the shopping; designer fashion, electrical goods and charming local souvenirs. It is also renowned as a gourmet's paradise, with an abundance of exceptional cafés and restaurants.

Originally a small fishing community and a haven for travellers and pirates, it was used by the British as a naval base during the Opium Wars with China. It remained a British colony from 1842 until sovereignty was transferred to the People's Republic of China in 1997.

## Dining

Renowned as the culinary capital of Asia, Hong Kong boasts more than 14,000 restaurants, many of which are clustered in defined food districts. In addition to enjoying the best Cantonese and regional Chinese food, visitors can sample a full range of authentic Asian cuisines as well as superb Western culinary delights. Hong Kong has 61 Michelin-starred restaurants.

## Kowloon

Kowloon is a bustling mixture of shops, fantastic bars, pubs, restaurants and markets. It is connected to Hong Kong Island by three tunnels and the MTR, but a trip across Victoria Harbour on a Star Ferry is the ideal way to commute between the two. Be tempted by the Temple Street Night Markets and wander along Nathan Road for its vast range of shopping. Take a stroll through the tranquil Nan Lian Garden.

## Hong Kong Island

Home to the original settlement of the Hong Kong territory, Victoria, Hong Kong Island is the city's financial and business hub, where charming colonial buildings sit next to modern skyscrapers. The island features restaurants, bars and shopping.

Visit the SoHo district for upscale boutiques, bars and a wide variety of restaurants. Travel on the tram car to Victoria Peak, pick-up some souvenirs or artworks and fashion at Stanley Market or dine at one of the famous floating restaurants on Aberdeen Harbour.

Today, Macau thrives on old-meets-new characteristics, its recent additions complementing the peninsula's historic legacies – now protected by UNESCO World Heritage status. Lovingly restored colonial architectural designs such as Barra Square, Lilau Square, St Augustine's Square, Senado Square, Cathedral Square and the Ruins of St Paul's continue to attract visitors. So too the Chinese treasures of Na Tcha Temple, Lou Kau Mansion and the much photographed A-Ma Temple on the waterfront.

Dwarfing many of the historic sites are the shapes and figures of a new Macau with its soaring 338 metre Macau Tower and modern Macau Convention Centre plus a growing number of sophisticated shopping centres, ritzy international hotels and restaurants. Macanese food is a fusion of Portuguese, African, Southeast Asian and Chinese cooking. Both on the peninsula and along the neon-lit Cotai Strip, there are 19 Michelin-starred restaurants in Macau.

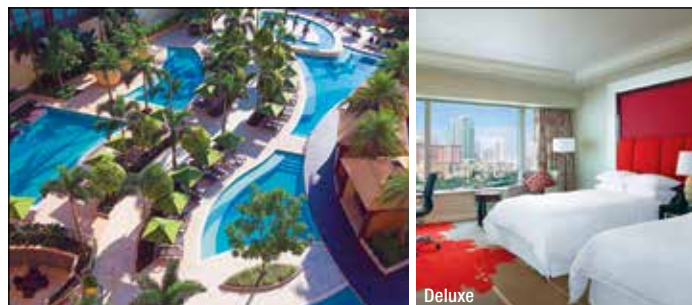

This includes (but is not limited to) loss, damage or loss of enjoyment which arises directly or indirectly from an Act of God, weather disruptions, dangers incidental to sea, fire, breakdown in machinery or equipment, acts of Government or authorities whether legitimate or not, wars whether declared or not, hostilities, acts of terrorism, civil disturbances, strikes, lockouts, riots, deaths, pilferage, epidemics, quarantines or medical, customs or immigration or emigration regulations.
- 1.3 We are not able to exercise control over services we do not supply directly, therefore we will not be responsible for any loss or damage arising from:
  - Any booking made directly with a service supplier by your travel agent or by yourself direct; or
  - Any services which are not provided by us and which are additional to those described in this brochure.
- 1.4 We will endeavour to provide the most suitable travel arrangements to meet the particular requirements you make known to us. However, travel is an individual experience, and your preferences and opinions may vary from our own. For this reason, we cannot take responsibility for your individual satisfaction, neither can we take responsibility for weather nor for compatibility of fellow guests or staff during the course of your travel.

## 2. Supply of Travel, Entertainment, Accommodation

- 2.1 Service and Facilities
- 2.2 When we make bookings with the providers of travel, accommodation, entertainment, activities, facilities or services ("the Suppliers") we are acting as a booking agent for the Suppliers.
- 2.3 All travel, entertainment, activities, and accommodation facilities or services are supplied directly to you by the Supplier. We have no control over the facilities or services themselves, or the manner in which they are provided by the Suppliers. Therefore you should be aware of the following conditions:
  - GO Holidays Limited will not be liable for any loss or damage of any kind that may arise from your use or consumption of, or inability to use or consume those facilities or services.
  - The provision of those facilities or services is subject to the terms and conditions of your contract with each Supplier.
  - Where for any reason, a Supplier is unable to provide particular facilities or services, then that Supplier may be entitled, under its contract with you to substitute those services or facilities with comparable or equivalent facilities or services without incurring any liability to you. You should check your contract with each Supplier.
  - All facilities or services described by us are subject to availability from the Supplier.
  - GO Holidays Limited will not be liable or responsible for any loss or damage relating to your baggage, personal possessions, health or welfare, or delays or travel disruptions unless these arise directly from the service we provide to you.

## 3. Business Purposes

You agree that where our services are acquired for business purposes, or where you hold yourself out as acquiring our services for business purposes, the Consumer Guarantees Act 1993 will not apply to any supply of goods or services made under these conditions, and we will not be liable or responsible for any loss or damage of any kind to you, including any consequential loss or damage however it may be caused.

## 4. Information in the Brochure

- 4.1 This brochure was published on 23 March 2017 and is valid for services used 1 April 2017 – 31 March 2018 unless otherwise advised. Exchange rates used when costing this brochure are as at 13 March 2017.

- 4.2 While we have exercised reasonable care and skill to ensure that the contents of this brochure are correct, accurate, and up-to-date at the time of publishing, please note that the contents of this brochure are based on information supplied to us by the Suppliers. We do not have, and cannot be reasonably expected to have, personal knowledge about all the facilities or services provided by each Supplier.
- 4.3 Facilities or services may change after the date of publication. We endeavour to keep travel agents informed of any changes to information in this brochure that are brought to our attention. Prior to booking your ticket, you should ask your travel agent about any changes to the published information of which your agent may be aware. You should also make sure that if your travel agent is advised of changes that occur after booking, your travel agent is able to contact you.
- 4.4 All maps, illustrations and photographs are for indicative purposes only and may not necessarily reflect actual places or positioning.
- 4.5 Accommodation must be consecutive at the same hotel to qualify for free nights. Important: Hotels have the right to change conditions e.g. 5th night free. Bonus offers: e.g. free upgrade or late checkouts are subject to availability at time of stay.

## 5. Prices

- 5.1 All prices shown in this brochure are on a per person basis unless otherwise stated and are expressed in New Zealand dollars. Vehicle rates are per vehicle.
- 5.2 Events beyond our control, such as currency fluctuations, changes to the price of aviation fuel or changes to the cost of services and facilities may result in the prices charged to you being different.
- 5.3 It must be understood that if for any of the reasons mentioned in Clause 5.2 price increases or variation of terms are notified to us between the time of booking and departure, we reserve the right to vary the price to you up to the time of your departure.
- 5.4 All prices exclude travel agent service fees.

## 6. Payment

- 6.1 A deposit of \$100 must be paid to your travel agent within seven (7) days of verbal or written confirmation of booking request. Certain Suppliers may also require an additional booking fee or deposit to be paid.
- 6.2 A booking requested less than seven (7) days prior to departure may incur communication charges.
- 6.3 Final payment shall in all cases be made not less than 30 days prior to departure. In some cases the terms of the tour or travel may require full payment at an earlier date. In that case you will be advised at the time your booking is processed.
- 6.4 Credit Card not permitted unless travel agent acts as merchant.

## 7. Amendment or Cancellation

- 7.1 If you wish, or circumstances require you to amend or cancel your booking for any reason, you should advise us in writing through your travel agent at the earliest possible time.
- 7.2 Where you cancel any booking more than thirty (30) days prior to your departure you are likely to have to pay a fee. A cancellation fee of \$200 will be imposed where cancellation is made within thirty (30) days prior to your departure, plus any suppliers charges as per note 7.3. Please refer however to Clause 7.6 for special conditions in some cases.
- 7.3 The above cancellation fees are required to offset booking, communication and administration charges that will have already been incurred by us. In addition to our cancellation fee, you may also be required to pay cancellation fees imposed by our Suppliers (i.e. airlines, hotels, etc.) The amount of each Supplier's cancellation fee is beyond our control, and payment is solely your responsibility. You should check with your travel agent concerning the amount of a Supplier's cancellation fees.
- 7.4 To the extent that we are able to do so (bearing in mind we are dependent upon third party availability beyond our control) we will be pleased to incorporate any reasonable changes you request. An itinerary change may attract a fee similar to cancellation fees in Clause 7.2 above to cover our administration costs.
- 7.5 Some Suppliers may reserve the right to cancel or amend travel, accommodation, etc and GO Holidays must therefore reserve similar rights to cancel or amend any holiday arrangements.

- 7.6 There are cases where the terms of supply as to refundability of pre-payments require provisions different from the above. In those cases the conditions specific to your tour will be advised to you at the time your booking is processed.

## 8. Insurance

We strongly recommend that as a minimum you insure yourself fully against cancellation, disruption, loss of luggage and personal property, and medical expenses. Your travel agent will be able to provide you with further information.

## 9. Items Not Covered
