









How to Get There

BY AIR Norfolk Island Airlines operate direct flights from Auckland every Saturday. Air New Zealand and Qantas also operate direct flights to Brisbane and Sydney from Auckland and Christchurch daily, from Wellington six to seven times a week and Queenstown and Dunedin seasonally.

Air New Zealand operates direct flights to Norfolk Island from Brisbane and Sydney twice a week, year round. Connecting flights are also available from other major Australian cities.

Visas and Passports

A passport valid for 6 months beyond the intended stay is required. A visa is not required for New Zealand passport holders.

Australian dollar (AUD). Travellers cheques and most credit cards are widely accepted.

The official language is English, but you'll hear the Islanders speaking Norfuk, a unique language derived from the Bounty Mutineers and their Tahitian wives.

Norfolk Island has some of the world's best beaches, however care and caution should be exercised at all times.

Driving

When driving a car, the standard left hand rule applies to driving on Norfolk Island. The maximum speed limit is 50km/h and this is reduced to 40km/h in the main town centre. All livestock roaming the roads have the right of way.


