Included Punting on the Avon: offers authentic punt rides along the Avon River and has been one of Christchurch's iconic attractions since 1986. An Edwardian-attired punter will guide you onboard a classic punt quietly past trailing willows, woodlands and the leafy banks of the Botanic Gardens; through the re-building city centre of Christchurch; Avon River Punting tours are set aboard handcrafted flat-bottomed boats, poled along by your Punter from the platform till at the aft of the boat. Punting on the Avon is an eco-friendly way to relax and enjoy Christchurch from a different perspective.

Included: The Christchurch City Tram – hop on hop off: A unique, and environmentally friendly way to see the city. It takes you around the 'must see' central attractions – get on and off as you please at any of the 17 stops including New Regent Street, Cathedral Junction, Avon River, Canterbury Museum, Botanical Gardens and many more. A full circuit takes 50 minutes and the Trams run approximately every 8 minutes in summer and every 15 minutes in winter, with commentary from the local guide. Included: 12:45pm: Dolphin watching cruise: Akaroa Harbour is host to amazing bird life and sea mammals, including the world's rarest and smallest dolphin, the friendly Hector Dolphin. The rear viewing platform is close to sea level providing you with the opportunity to get up close to these playful dolphins. Watch out for fur seals sunbathing on the rocks, little blue penguins, marine salmon, Paua, and pearl farm. The harbour is known for a variety of fascinating sea birds including five species of cormorant, black-backed gulls, red-billed gulls, shearwaters, terns, prions, mollymawks, petrels, skuas, oystercatchers, albatross and more. The vessel is fast, stable and manoeuvrable allowing you to visit the spectacular sea caves, volcanic formations, high cliffs and bird nesting sites both within Akaroa Harbour and beyond the entrance along the Pacific Ocean coastline. A comprehensive commentary on geology, history, ecology and Maori heritage and traditions is included. Barkers of Geraldine. We are delighted to introduce you to Michael Barker – 3rd generation of this well-known New Zealand Family. Michael will host you at the Barker's Foodstore & Eatery for a personal history and insight into the 50-year history of Barker's, showcase the development of their food products, and you will visit to the Barkers exhibit in the Geraldine museum.

The Barker family name is synonymous with Geraldine after Anthony Barker and his wife Gillian started preserving and bottling local fruits in 1969. Barker's of Geraldine is still located on a corner of the original family farm, 8km from the South Canterbury town of Geraldine. The farm sits in the lea of the Four Peaks mountain range, beside the Te Moana River and surrounded by rolling pastures. The farm is now a thriving business, making world-class jams, chutneys, syrups, and condiments. Barker's supports the local community employing over 200 local people, and always buys local produce whenever possible.
