26 June - Istanbul

This morning start your day with a short walk from your hotel to visit the Basilica Cistern – an underground water storage system designed in the 6th century. Continue to the vibrant Spice Market where you can try some of the local delicacies before finishing at the Grand Bazaar where many bargains can be found and bartered for.

This morning you will be picked up from your hotel lobby around 07:00 to travel to Eceabat, arriving around midday. On arrival you will be met by the local guide and escorted to a local restaurant for lunch. After lunch, depart on a guided tour of Gallipoli visiting Brighton Beach, Beach Cemetery, ANZAC Cove, Ariburnu Cemetery, ANZAC Commemorative Site, Mehmetcik Statue, Lone Pine Australian Memorial, Johnston's Jolly (Turkish and Allied trenches and tunnels), Turkish 57th Infantry Regiment Cemetery, The Nek Cemetery and Chunuk Bair New Zealand Memorial. Upon completion of the tour you will be transferred to your hotel for an overnight stay including dinner at a local restaurant.




